ARBITRAL AWARD

This matter was heard by the undersigned as an arbitrator on February 18, 2000. I find the following facts:

1. On or about October 26, 1996 at 4:11 p.m., Plaintiff Richard French was driving a 1982 4 door Buick south on West Avon Road, Avon.

2. Slightly south of the intersection with Country Club Road, Plaintiff Richard French stopped to make a left turn into a plaza. His left turn signal was on.

3. Defendant Jason B. Foster was driving south on West Avon Road, Avon, Connecticut in a 1986 2 door Chevrolet owned by Defendant Avis M. Foster.

4. The Chevrolet driven by Defendant Jason B. Foster hit the rear of the Buick driven by Plaintiff Richard French, forcing the Buick into oncoming traffic (where it hit a 1996 Honda owned and operated by Jocelyn E.

Jackman).

5. Plaintiff Richard French incurred medical bills totaling \$5,238.00.

6. No lost wages were proven, although Plaintiff Richard French claims to have missed "a couple of days" from work.

7. Plaintiff Richard French suffered a 4% permanent partial disability to the cervical spine.

8. Plaintiff Richard French has incurred damages totalling \$30,198.00 due to Defendants' fault.
